- Maintain liaison and establish strong network in close collaboration with the Senior Program Specialist and pursue its rigorous development for timely and speedy data/information acquisition and transfer.

- Establish a common system for data storage, retrieval and access through electronic media and ensure its functionality.
- Collection, collation and constant updating of data/information in all areas of agriculture and related others both at the national and regional aggregate level.
- Select, analyse, code and structure database systems.
- Develop programs to cater the needs of the SAC divisions, maintenance and trouble shooting of hard and software for maximizing output and to support users need.
- Should be able to design web and maintain it, good command on LAN and WAN and working experience on installation and configuration of OS and application packages.
- Assess the data needs of the Centre.
- Design and implement the Management Information System (MIS) of respective Divisions of SAC
- Organize training courses for the officials and staffs on computer application and ICT.
- Ensure timely production of reports, papers etc.
- Assist SPS and the Director as and when needed and as per assignment.

Qualification and Experience required
